

1. Click on bookcover for Bat-Chen Lesson/Study Guide.

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Slide 2. Read story to students, go over map. Click on "Prium" to get definition.

Click on CNN for article about bombing.

Click on TIME for article about Arab-Israel Conflict.

Click on Google Earth (must be on computer and linked) to find Tel Aviv, Israel.

Slide 3- Pull out the photos and discuss with class.

Pull out yellow text and discuss with class.

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2. Use your cursor to pull out the pencils in the top right corner and it will tell you about the drawing in the background.

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Slide 6- Discuss with students if writing really does help your emotions. Then read the example and erase the black box.

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Slide 7- Read with students and ask the questions. Then use eraser to erase boxes.

Ending- Have students answer question in middle.

Click on gas mask for copy of story.

Slide 8- Look diaries from other teenagers in war by reading "Why Do They Hate Me?" Click on Bookcover for more info.

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Slide 10-

1. Questions for students:

Which animal represents you, why? Which would your dad (mom, sister, brother) be, why??

2. Go to the middle of the picture with the handle of the magnifying glass to get the story of this drawing.

3. Use the handle of the magnifying glass to drag it accross the animals to reviel what Bat-Chen said about her family.

4. Why do you think Bat-Chen's parents choose this picture to be in the EOD exhibit?

HOT Questions will help you think of questions for artwork.

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Slide 12- Talk about the drawings by Bat-Chen and ask students to analyze drawings.

Then click on the "How to keep a scetchbook" for ideas regarding keeping a book of drawings.

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Slide 13- Use this EOD artwork to discuss how

other teenagers around the world see war.

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Slide 14- Ask student questions about the incident that led up to Bat-Chen's death. Erase the black box to see if they are correct.

Click on CNN for article of bombing.

Click on Time for history of Arab-Israel Conflict.

Click on FCAT Stem questions for ideas for article questions.

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Slide 15- Click on "United in Grief" an article about Bat-Chen and her family from People Magazine.

Visit Bat-Chen's website.

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Slide 16- Students can read interview with parents.

Students can do mock interview with roles of parents.

Students can research the "Justvision" website.

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Slide 17- Video is Israel's teenagers speaking about the war. It is at [www.youtube.com](http://www.youtube.com). Type in "Israel teenagers" in search.

Click on Website and analyze them.

Click on Do Something for suggestions.

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Slide 19- How can this piece of artwork express our theme "The Power of One"?

Slide 20- Drag magnifying glass across bottom of picture.

Slide 21- After answering questions with students, pull down "ripped" paper in upper corner to see answers through picture.

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Slide 22- Compare EOD quote with Bat-Chen's.

Pull out star to read under Hebrew.
