

#1 Explain Title and Quote. Find box behind picture. FCAT Question Stems AND Higher Order Thinking Questions are located in the bottom right corner to use throughout the lesson. Questions need to be modified to reflect artwork and quotes.

#2 Using Kagan's "Think, Pair Share" Have students describe the characteristics of this person...then point out that they are really judging him/her. Discuss "is it okay to judge"? (pull out yellow under title).

#3 Have students guess. Have them give your reasons why they chose what they did. Pull out word behind picture.

#4 Use reveal tool to look at questions first.. Prepare students to accept a different theory. Talk about what art represents. Behind picture is artist statement.

#6 Go over definition of eugenics. Use artwork to help explain eugenics.

Art info under picture, just drag out.

#7 Pages from German Medical Book in 1930-40s. Eugenics was taught in schools as a subject. Colleges had courses on it.

---

#8 Use this to talk about how America also believed in Eugenics. Talk about Japanese Internment Camps during WWII.

---

#9 Go over these statements on DNA. Click on Learning Genetics for Interactive ways to learn about DNA.

Talk about quote and relate it to DNA/Genes.

#10 Have two students come to front of room. Describe differences and similarities between them.

Pull out questions on left. Answers:

1. 99.9%

2. eye color, hair color /texture, skin color, height, weight, etc...

#11 Part 2 of Race video...

"The Story We Tell". History of America and its superiority complex using "White Man's Burden" and "Manifest Destiny". Talk to students about art (info under artwork), Political Cartoons and quote. Relate them to these ideas.

#12 Part 3 of Race Video-

"The House We Live In".

Talk about White Flight and what led up to it.
