The annual juried outdoor exhibit, which celebrates and promotes diversity, received more than 20,000 entries from 115 countries and 48 states before winners were chosen for display. Students from 204 schools around the world submitted artworks or quotes; 49 of this year's winners were students, with 33 of those from local schools—including Best-in-Show Student award winner Carly Stafford, a senior at Booker High, for her work *Hear No Evil, See No Evil, Speak No Evil*. Best-in-Show Adult winner was Dylan Cacador of Rhode Island for his work entitled *Pulse, Pride, Hope*, reflecting on the tragedy of the mass shooting at the Pulse Night Club. The exhibit's winning inspirational quote: Sarasota Middle sixth-grader Jessica Ritchie's, "If you don't fit into a scene, always remember there's a bigger picture."
